This is the second time we did this roof,

the first time being about 6 years ago and our John 3:16 plaque is still in place as you can see by the pictures below. We wondered what had happened to the older of the two boys when we were applying the roof, why wasn't he there to help? While we were having the meal the neighbours prepared, the older boy arrives with 2 big bags of cooked chicken, oh boy can they afford this? We shared the meal, played "I Can Only Imagine", applied Jessica's plaque, gave out Bibles, another amazing day, Thank You Lord!!!!
